TO APPROPRIATE \$10,000 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS FUND FOR THE ENERGY OFFICE COMPETITIVE DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS MINI-GRANTS PROGRAM

**SUMMARY BACKGROUND:**

The South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff-Energy Office receives formula-based funding through the U.S. Department of Energy State Energy Program to reduce energy use in the State by implementing programs to increase energy efficiency and the use of renewable energy. The Department of Parks and Recreation applied for and was awarded \$10,000 from the South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff-Energy Office's Competitive Demonstration Projects Mini-Grants Program. The grant award will help purchase and install solar panels at the David Hellams Community Center.

**IMPACT IF DENIED:**

The City will have to reject the grant award.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

This grant supports an existing project to install solar panels at the David Hellams Community Center. The total project cost is \$80,000 and the funds are available in the Parks and Recreation Neighborhood Parks Program.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage on the second and final reading.
