## **GREENLINK EXPANDS BIKE LOCKER PROGRAM**

**(GREENVILLE, SC)** Greenlink has expanded its bike locker program by installing two new BikeLids at County Square. This addition brings Greenlink's inventory to 10 lockers, with six located along Richardson Street outside the Greenlink Transit Center and two inside the South Spring Street Garage.

According to marketing specialist Nicole McAden, much like the bicycle racks on the buses and the bike share station outside the Greenlink Transit Center, the bike locker program is part of Greenlink's ongoing efforts to improve connections to public transportation in the Greenville area, and its commitment to creating a multimodal transportation system.

Each BikeLid can accommodate up to two bicycles and is equipped with an individually keyed lock, giving access to the renter alone. Benefits of the locker include protection from inclement weather and security against theft and vandalism. The cost to rent a locker is \$50 for six months, and requires an additional \$40 refundable deposit for the key and lock. Greenlink provides fixed route transportation services Monday through Saturday throughout Greenville County. The system operates the Clemson Commuter, Clemson Connector and CU-ICAR/St. Francis Shuttle, and owns and operates Greenville's downtown trolleys. The Greenlink system also includes Greenville Area Paratransit (GAP), an ADA service for those unable to use Greenlink's fixed route service.
