JOIN US FOR A COMMUNITY BIKE RIDE WITH MIA BIRK

Meet at 5 PM near the entrance to the Greenville Zoo in Cleveland Park. This short (less than 2.5 mile) casual ride is open to the public and accessible for bicyclists of all ages and skill levels. This group ride will venture toward downtown on parts of the Swamp Rabbit Trail and then hop on some of the City's on-street bicycle facilities and bike friendly streets through downtown. The brief ride will end at the Greenville Little Theater, the site of Mia Birk's evening key-note presentation and reception.

A designated bike parking area will be provided, but riders should provide their own secure bike locks. Riders are strongly encouraged to wear helmets.

A free community event at the Greenville Little Theatre that will feature a Key Note presentation by Mia on the benefits of a bicycle & pedestrian friendly community and how to build multi-mobile transportation networks that serve a diversity of users. Mia will share her observations of Greenville and discuss her experience working in Portland, OR as well as communities throughout the country. She will suggest some simple action steps that can begin transforming how we think about the relationships between economic development, land-use, public health, mobility, public policy, and the environment. Attendees will have an opportunity to submit questions to Mia ahead of the presentation.

Attendees will enjoy food and drinks (served in biodegradable cups); as well as have an opportunity to purchase a copy of Mia's book *Invidis Pedaling Toward a Healthier Planet* and to have it signed by the author.
