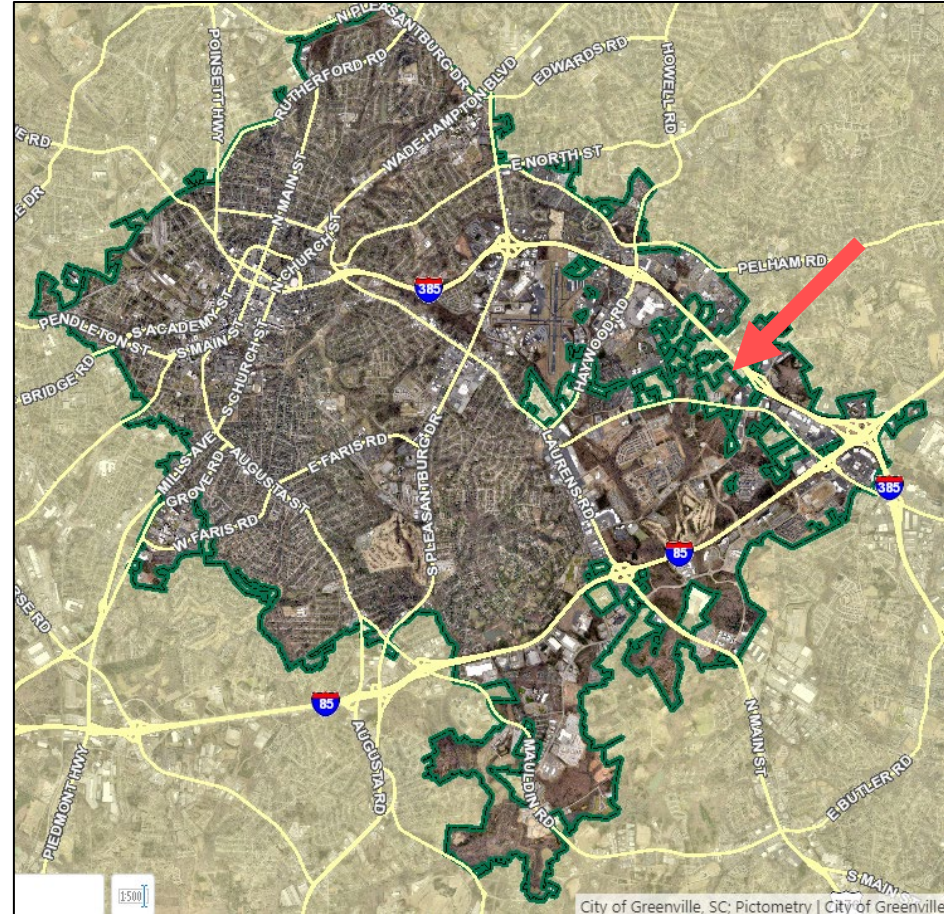

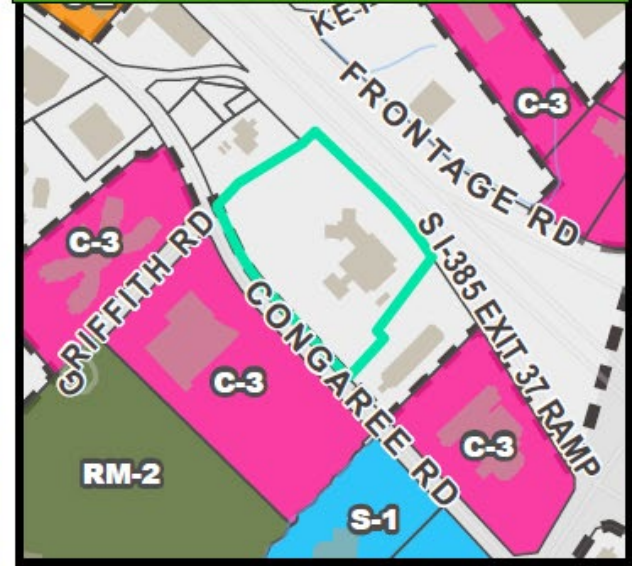

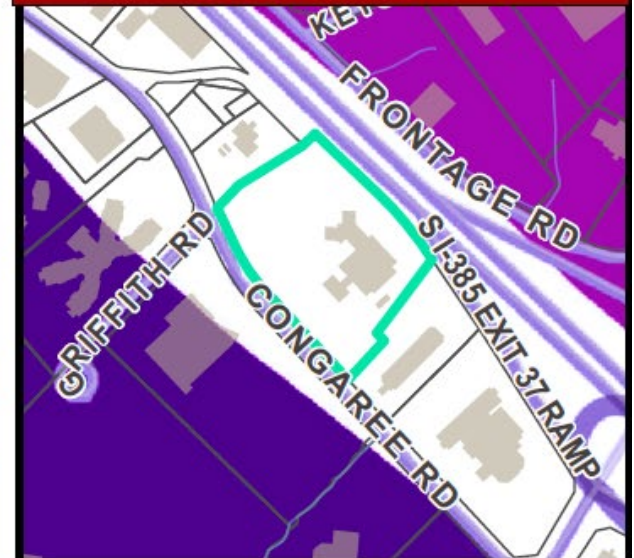
AERIAL VIEW



CURRENT ZONING

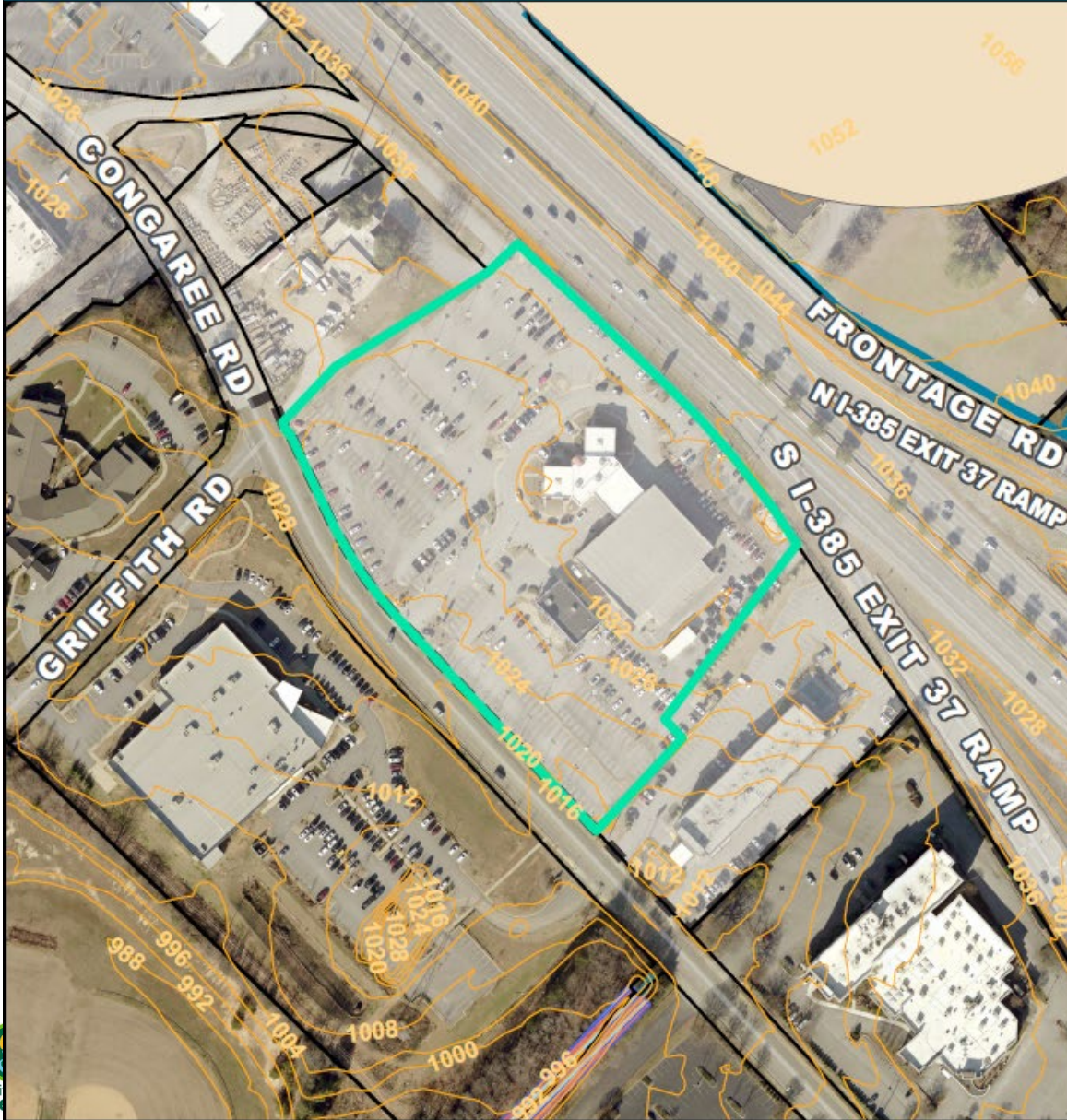


FUTURE LAND USE

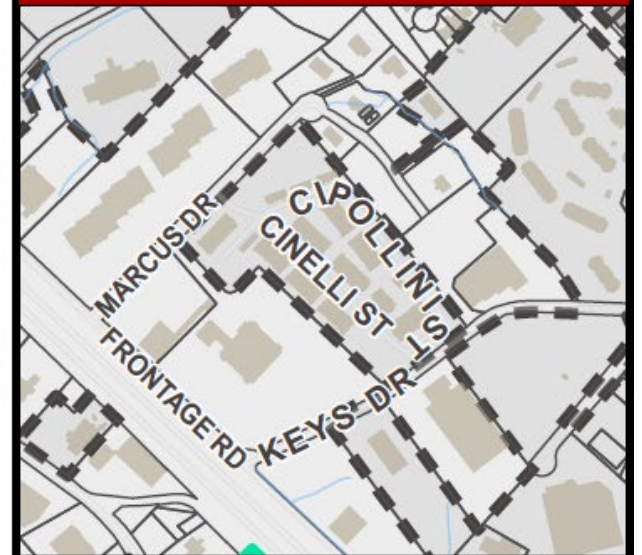

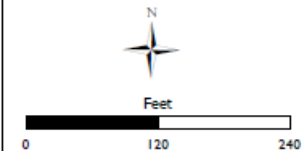
