ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$525,437 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANT FUND FOR SOUTH CAROLINA OPIOID RECOVERY FUNDS

**SUMMARY BACKGROUND:**

The city of Greenville participated in opioid-related litigation settlements led by the State of South Carolina, through its Attorney General Alan Wilson, as a Participating Political Subdivision. Because of the efforts of the State of South Carolina and Litigating Political Subdivisions, the State and its Political Subdivisions will receive the benefits of opioid-related settlements.

To access a portion of its available Guaranteed Political Subdivision Subfund Allocation, the City of Greenville was required to submit a Technical Proposal seeking funding for an approved abatement strategy to the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board. The City proposed launching a new Opioid Response Team under the operation of the Greenville City Fire Department. The Opioid Response Team will use a combination of preventative outreach initiatives, education, and emergency response to remediate the impact of the opioid epidemic in Greenville. The proposal was approved by the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board and the portion of funds requested from the City's Subfund Allocation, in the amount of \$525,437, have been released to the City to support the creation and development of the Opioid Response Team in its first year.

**IMPACT IF DENIED:**

If denied, the City will be unable to establish the Opioid Response Team.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The City will accept funding of \$525,437 to establish the Opioid Response Team.

TO APPROPRIATE \$525,437 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANT FUND FOR SOUTH CAROLINA OPIOID RECOVERY FUNDS

WHEREAS, the city of Greenville (“City”) participated in opioid-related litigation settlements led by the State of South Carolina, through its Attorney General Alan Wilson, as a Participating Political Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, because of the efforts of the State of South Carolina and Litigating Political Subdivisions, the State and its Political Subdivisions will receive the benefits of opioid-related settlements; and

WHEREAS, to access a portion of its available Guaranteed Political Subdivision Subfund Allocation, the City was required to submit a Technical Proposal seeking funding for an approved abatement strategy to the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Technical Proposal to launch a new Opioid Response Team under the operation of the Greenville City Fire Department was approved by the South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, the Opioid Response Team will use a combination of preventative outreach initiatives, education, and emergency response to remediate the impact of the opioid epidemic in Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the funding requested and awarded, \$525,437, will be used to establish and to support the Opioid Response Team in its first year; and

WHEREAS, no additional funds are needed to complete this project in its first year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the amount of \$525,437 is appropriated in the Miscellaneous Grant Fund to support creation of the Opioid Response Team under the direction of the Greenville City Fire Department as reflected in the attached Exhibit. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage on the second and final reading.
