Resolution of support for City Clerk Camilla Pitman, MMC, PLS, in submitting an application for candidacy to the Office of Vice President of the International Institute of Municipal Clerks, and to support her ascension to the Office of President

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

City Council has a long history of supporting its employees in the advancement of their education and professional aspirations. City Clerk Camilla Pitman desires to, and is fully qualified to, apply and compete in the 2024 election of the Office of IIMC Vice President, which, if successful, ascends to the office of IIMC President in three years.

WHEREAS, Camilla G. Pitman, MMC, PLS, has served in her capacity as City Clerk of the city of Greenville since October 3, 2007; and prior to serving as City Clerk, Ms. Pitman served as Legal Office Coordinator (June 1995-March 2007) and Municipal Court Clerk of Court (March-October 2007); and

WHEREAS, during her tenure as City Clerk, Ms. Pitman has served as 2016-2017 President and as a member of the Board of Directors (2012-2018) for the South Carolina Municipal Finance Officers, Clerks, and Treasurers Association, and as IIMC Region III Director (2019-2022) on the IIMC Board of Directors, representing the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Pitman has been a member in good standing of the International Institute of Municipal Clerks since July 2008 and has served as an Ambassador of the City as a participant in IIMC Annual Conference events, including as a presenter on the state, region, and international levels; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Pitman has consistently attended IIMC Annual Conferences since 2009 and has served on IIMC Committees since 2012, including the Conference Committee, Education and Professional Development Committee, Elections Committee, Mentoring Committee, Policy Review Committee, and Public Relations and Marketing Committee, serving as Chairman of three of the Committees; and
