TO APPROPRIATE \$57,500 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS FUND FOR FY 2019 GRANT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL AND TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF OTHER CITY FUNDS AS LOCAL MATCH FOR THE GRANT

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The City of Greenville's Public Works Department applied for and received four grants totaling \$57,500 from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control. A grant in the amount of \$25,000, awarded under the FY 2019 Solid Waste Management Grant Program, will be used to install recycling bins throughout the City's parks. This grant requires a \$3,000 City Match which is available in the Solid Waste Fund. A grant in the amount of \$25,000, awarded under the FY 2019 Solid Waste Management Grant Program, will be used to conduct citywide recycling and education outreach campaigns. A grant in the amount of \$3,750, awarded under the FY 2019 Used Motor Oil Recycling Grant Program, will be used to educate the public on the proper collection and disposal of used oil and for professional development activities. A grant in the amount of \$3,750, awarded under the FY 2019 Waste Tire Recycling Grant Program, will be used to educate the public on the proper collection and disposal of used tires and for professional development activities.

IMPACT IF DENIED:

If denied, the grant awards will be rejected.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Project completion will require \$3,000 in city matching funds which are available in the Solid Waste Fund.

WHEREAS, a grant in the amount of \$25,000, awarded under the FY 2019 Solid Waste Management Grant Program, will be used to conduct citywide recycling and education outreach campaigns; and

WHEREAS, a grant in the amount of \$3,750, awarded under the FY 2019 Used Motor Oil Recycling Grant Program, will be used to educate the public on the proper collection and disposal of used oil and for professional development activities; and

WHEREAS, a grant in the amount of \$3,750, awarded under the FY 2019 Waste Tire Recycling Grant Program, will be used to educate the public on the proper collection and disposal of used tires and for professional development activities; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$3,000 are committed as matching funds for the recycling bins grant and are available in the Solid Waste Fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the amount of \$57,500 is appropriated in the Miscellaneous Grant Fund for the programs described above and as reflected in the attached Exhibit. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage on the second and final reading.
