SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The city of Greenville Fire Department received a grant in the amount of \$60,000 from the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division through the 2020 South Carolina State Homeland Security Program. The grant will be used to train and equip the Upstate Regional Collapse Search & Rescue Team. No additional funds will be needed.
