AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$27,229 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS FUND FOR THE FY2020 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The Bureau of Justice Assistance's JAG Program FY2020 Local Solicitation was accepting applications from units of government to provide additional personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, training, technical assistance, and information systems for criminal justice. The Greenville Police Department was eligible to apply for \$27,229 and proposed to use the funds to purchase one electric motorcycle and accompanying equipment to expand its existing patrol motorcycle program. The electric motorcycle will improve the Police Department's ability to respond to vehicle collisions in high-traffic areas and increase patrols throughout the City's park system. The Bureau of Justice Assistance has approved the proposal.

IMPACT IF DENIED:

The City will have to reject the grant award.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Minimal additional funds may be needed to complete this project.

WHEREAS, the Greenville Police Department was awarded \$27,229 through the FY2020 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Local Solicitation from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville Police Department will use the grant funds received to purchase one electric motorcycle and accompanying equipment to expand its existing patrol motorcycle program; and

WHEREAS, the electric motorcycle will improve the Police Department’s ability to respond to vehicle collisions in high-traffic areas and increase patrols throughout the City’s park system; and

WHEREAS, minimal additional funds may be needed to complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the amount of \$27,229 is appropriated in the Miscellaneous Grants Fund to support the purchase of one electric motorcycle as reflected in the attached Exhibit. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage on the second and final reading.
