AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$31,926 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS FUND FOR THE FY2021 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The Bureau of Justice Assistance's JAG Program FY2021 Local Solicitation accepted applications from units of government to provide additional personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, training, technical assistance, and information systems for criminal justice. The Greenville Police Department applied for \$31,926 in grant funding and proposed to use the funds to support intervention counseling and mentoring services for its Gang Reduction and Violence Intervention Targeting Youth (GRAVITY) program. The Bureau of Justice Assistance has approved the application and proposal.

IMPACT IF DENIED:

The City will have to reject the grant award.

Matching funds are not required.

AN ORDINANCE

TO APPROPRIATE \$31,926 IN THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS FUND FOR THE FY2021 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Greenville Police Department applied for \$31,926 in grant funding through the FY2021 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Local Solicitation from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance approved the application; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville Police Department will use the funds received to further the success of its Gang Reduction and Violence Intervention Targeting Youth (GRAVITY) program; and

WHEREAS, the funds will also be used to provide intervention counseling and mentoring services to youth at risk of continued or new involvement with gangs; and

WHEREAS, matching funds are not required to complete this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, the amount of \$31,926 is appropriated in the Miscellaneous Grants Fund to support the GRAVITY program as reflected in the attached Exhibit. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage on the second and final reading.
