ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION CAPTION:

Ordinance to prohibit the operation of trucks on Haynie Street between South Church Street (US-29) and Augusta Street (SC-20)

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The City has recently assumed ownership of Haynie Street. Haynie Street provides access to residential land use within the historic Haynie-Sirrine neighborhood. Haynie Street carries around 2,500 vehicles per day with approximately 6% percent heavy vehicle traffic as measured in December of 2020. Trucks are using Haynie Street as an east-west cut-through connection between South Church Street to Augusta Street to access businesses along Augusta Street, South Church Street and Dunbar Street. Access to these businesses and Dunbar Street can be accomplished by remaining on South Church Street and Augusta Street.

IMPACT IF DENIED:


Heavy vehicles will continue to use Haynie Street as a cut-through, impacting the safety and quality of life of the residents.



A N O R D I N A N C E

TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF TRUCKS ON HAYNIE STREET BETWEEN SOUTH CHURCH STREET (US-29) AND AUGUSTA STREET (SC-20)

WHEREAS, Haynie Street between South Church Street (US-29) and Augusta Street (SC-20) is owned by the city of Greenville; and

WHEREAS, this section of Haynie Street consists primarily of residential land use; and

WHEREAS, trucks with six wheels or more are using this section of Haynie Street as an east-west cut-through connection to access businesses along Augusta Street, South Church Street and Dunbar Street; and

WHEREAS, Section 42-43, Trucks prohibited on certain streets, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Greenville allows for city street posting of “No Through Trucks” by the City Engineer upon approval by City Council, except for pickup and delivery on such street; and

WHEREAS, viable and more appropriate alternative routes currently exist for truck traffic using South Church Street and Augusta Street; and

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, City Council desires to prohibit through trucks on that section of Haynie Street as described below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate on Haynie Street between South Church Street and Augusta Street any vehicle with over six wheels except as necessary to make deliveries or pick up freight for properties with no other access.
