15. NEW BUSINESS – (Ordinances – First Reading)

- a. A Ninth Supplemental Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of a not exceeding \$7,700,000 City of Greenville, South Carolina, Sewer System Revenue Bond, Series 2022 in one or more series; and other matters relating thereto

- c. Ordinance to approve an Agreement between the City of Greenville and Chad R. Stepp for the purchase of property at 5 Wilshire Drive and to appropriate \$68,500 for the purchase of said property

Councilmember Dowe asked how the funding is accounted for in the budget. Office of Management and Budget Director Matt Efird responded that it is part of owner contingency and if approved, it would be pulled from contingency.

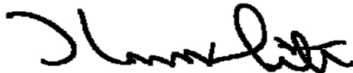
