

SPINX RUN FEST - TRAFFIC NOTICE

Spinx Run Fest presented by The Greenville Track Club will take place on **Saturday October 26, 2019**. Roads will be closed for brief periods during the morning hours, in most cases involving only one lane of travel. Uniformed City Police will monitor key intersections and control traffic to protect the safety of motorists and runners. All points along the route will be open for emergency service access at all times. Roads will be re-opened to normal traffic on a progressive basis as runners proceed through the race courses. *The schedule of events impacting DOWNTOWN GREENVILLE is as follows:*

6:15AM-11:30AM - Marathon, Half Marathon, 10K & 5K:

Roads to be partially or fully CLOSED include: River Street from W. Broad Street to S. Main St., S. Main from Augusta Street to Markley Street, S. Markley St., and Field St.

7:20AM-7:45AM - Half Marathon and 10K:

Roads to be partially or fully CLOSED include: Augusta Street from Main Street to S. Church Street.

8:00AM-9:00AM - 5K (See Attached Map):

Roads to be partially or fully CLOSED include: W. Broad Street, W. Washington Street, and S. Hudson Street.

Suggested Detours at partially or fully closed sections (always follow directions of Uniformed Officers): Areas north of Main St. to Broad should detour along all roads to Academy for access in any direction. Academy will remain open at all locations. Areas south of Main St. to Broad should detour to Augusta (*BUT NOT FROM 7:20AM to 7:45AM*). West Broad from Main to Washington will be affected. Areas west of W. Broad should detour to Academy for access into and out of the area. Cox Street will be closed to traffic in the area under the Academy overpass at Linky Stone Park.

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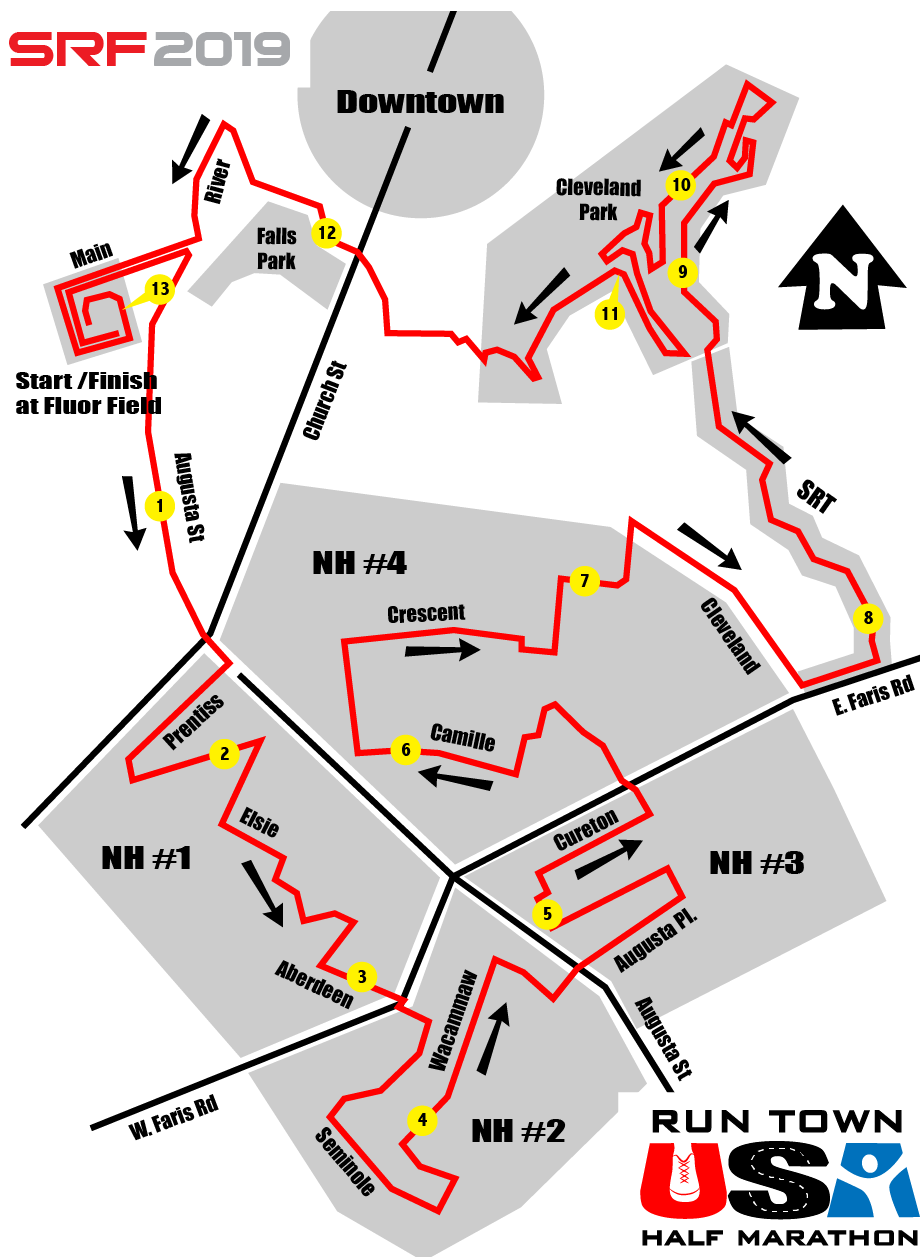
NEIGHBORHOODS #1, #2, #3 & #4

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Run Town USA Half Marathon & Downtown 10K, 7:20AM Start: See attached course map.

Roads to be partially or fully CLOSED include: **NH #1** - Augusta Street (one lane), W. Prentiss Avenue, Aurthur Avenue, Catechee Avenue, Keowee Avenue, Elsie Avenue, Aberdeen Drive, N. Brookwood Drive, Brookwood Drive, and Melville Avenue. **NH #2** - Wormy Lane, Tomassee Avenue, Seminole Drive, Sunset Drive, Meyers Drive, Waccamaw Drive, Westminister Drive, and W. Augusta Place. **NH #3** - E. Augusta Place, McCuen Street, Stewart Street, and Cureton Street. **NH #4** - Ottaway Drive, Lanneau Drive, McPherson Lane, Camille Avenue, Capers Street, Crescent Avenue, Afton Avenue, Mclver Street, and Cleveland Street.

Suggested Detours at partially or fully closed sections (always follow directions of Uniformed Officers): The Augusta Street/Church Street intersection will be closed briefly (starting approximately 7:55am) as runners cross. Use East Faris Road to travel north during this short period. Runners will proceed toward Faris Road, therefore use Church Street instead of Faris to travel north after the Church/Augusta intersection is clear. Traffic on Augusta will be slowed due to runners taking up one southbound lane from Fluor Field to W. Prentiss Avenue. Runners will cross Augusta Street at Augusta Place, requiring frequent halting of traffic in both directions at this location. Traffic will also be temporarily halted on W. Faris at Aberdeen, and on E. Faris at McCuen Street to allow runners to cross these busy streets. (End of Notice)

Augusta St from S Main St to W Prentiss Ave (7:25AM to 8:00AM), **W Prentiss Ave** from Augusta St to Mission St (7:30AM to 8:00AM), **Mission St** from W Prentiss Ave to Arthur Ave (7:30AM to 8:15AM), **Arthur Ave** from Mission St to Grove Rd (7:30AM to 8:15AM), **Catechee Ave** from Grove Rd to Augusta St (7:30AM to 8:15AM), **Lupo St** from Augusta St to Eagle Ave (7:30AM to 8:20AM), **Eagle Ave** from Lupo Alley to Crescent Ave (7:30AM to 8:20AM), **Crescent Ave** from Eagle Ave to Capers St (7:35AM to 8:25AM), **Crescent Ave** from Capers St to Afton Ave (7:35AM to 8:30AM), **Afton Ave** from Crescent Ave to McIver St (7:35AM to 8:30AM), **McIver St** from Afton Ave to Cleveland St (7:35AM to 8:30AM), **Southland Ave** from Cleveland St to Boxwood Ln (7:35AM to 8:30AM), **Boxwood Ln** from Southland Ave to Woodland Way (7:40AM to 8:40AM), **Woodland Way** from Southland Ave to Woodland Way Cir (7:40AM to 8:45AM), **River St** from SRT to S Main St (7:50AM to 9:00AM), **S.
