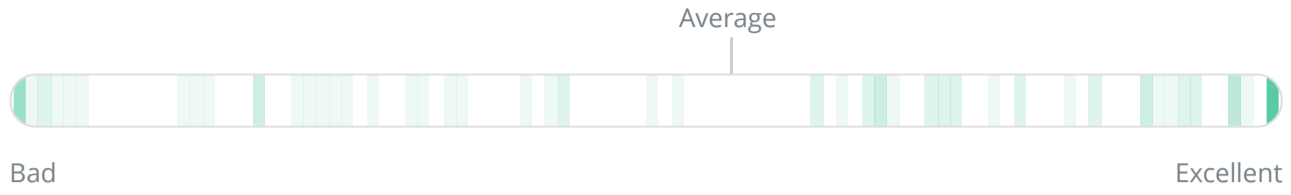

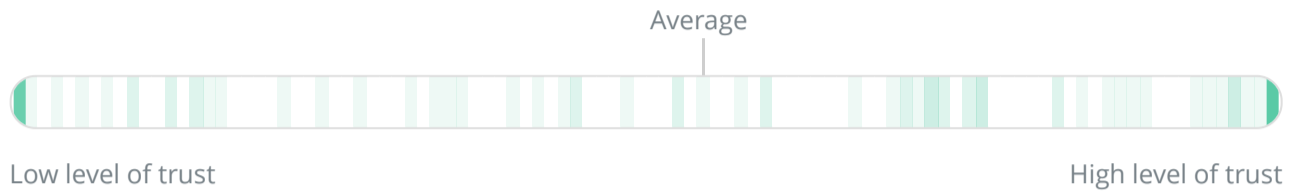

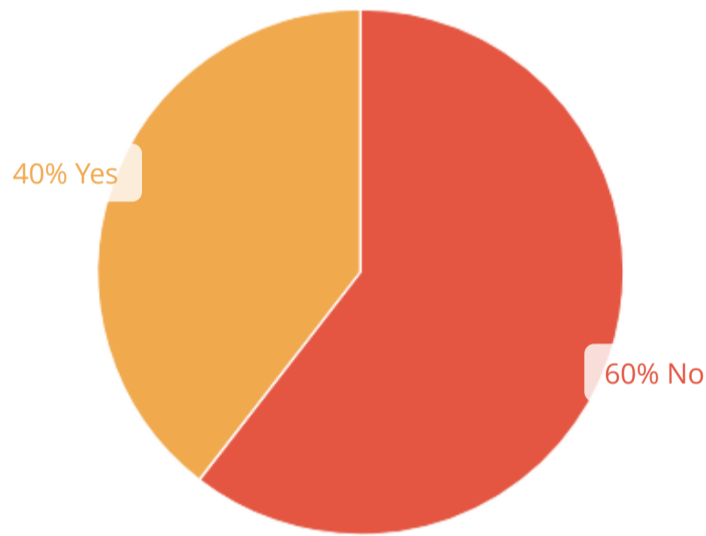

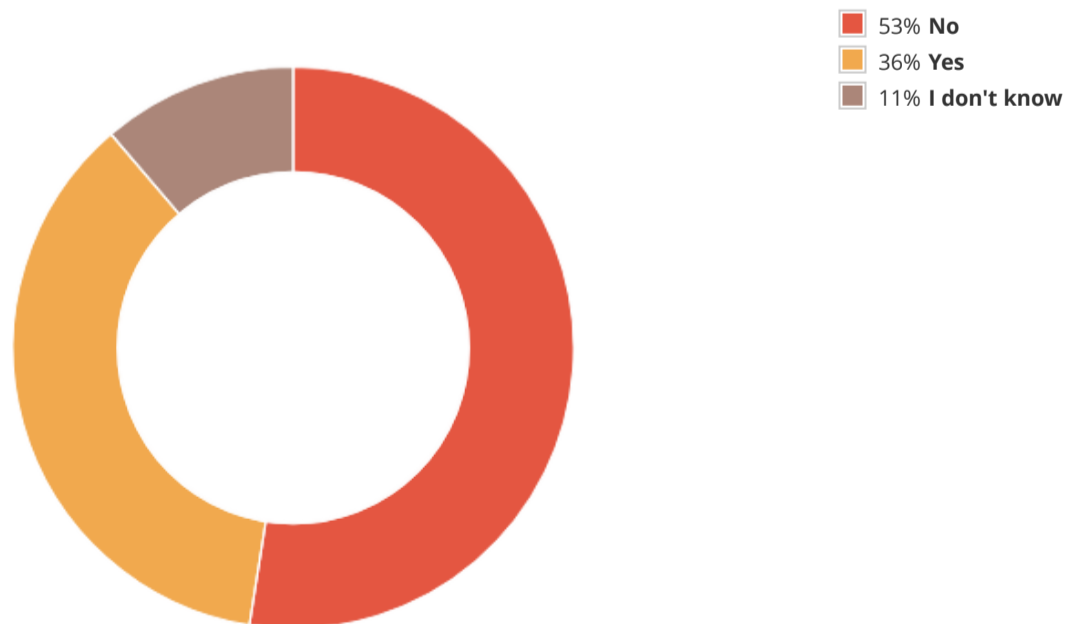

* In general, do you believe that law enforcement throughout the nation treats all racial/ethnic groups fairly?

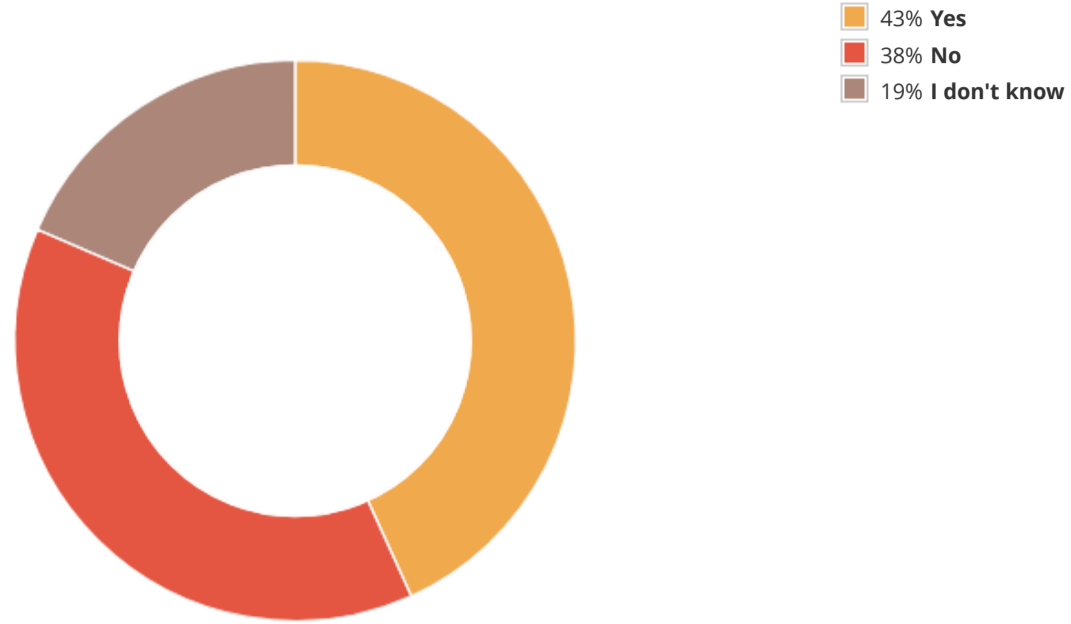

* In general, do you believe that Greenville Police Department officers treat all racial/ethnic groups fairly?

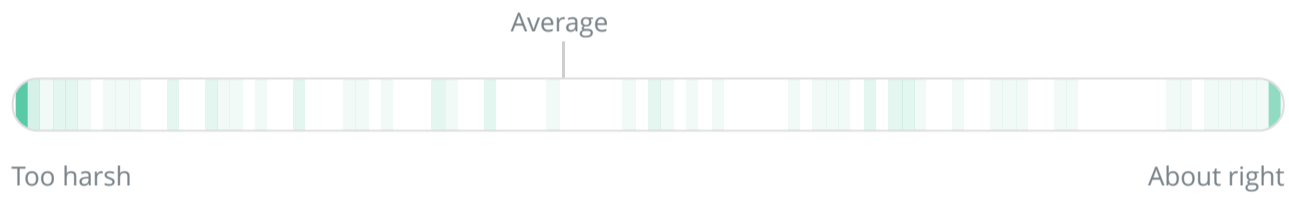

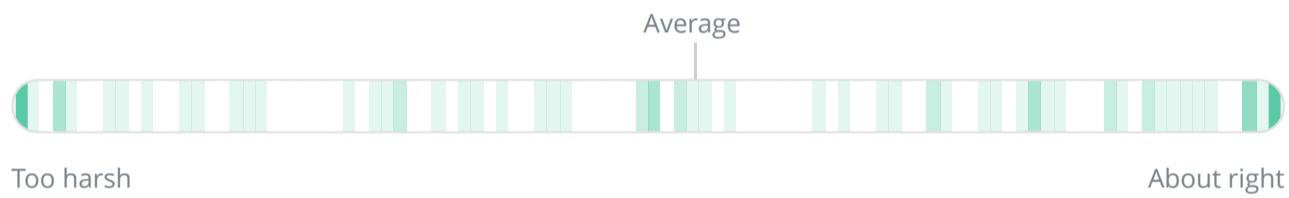
* In general, how would you describe the tactics used by law enforcement throughout the nation? Use your mouse or finger to adjust the slider below.

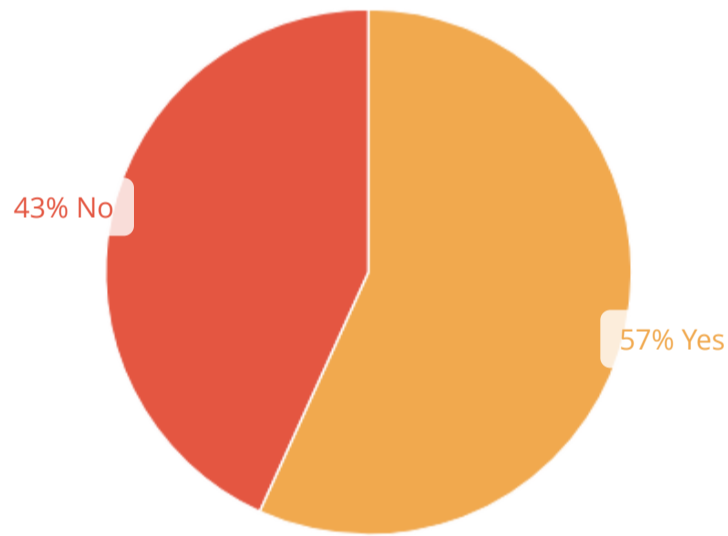

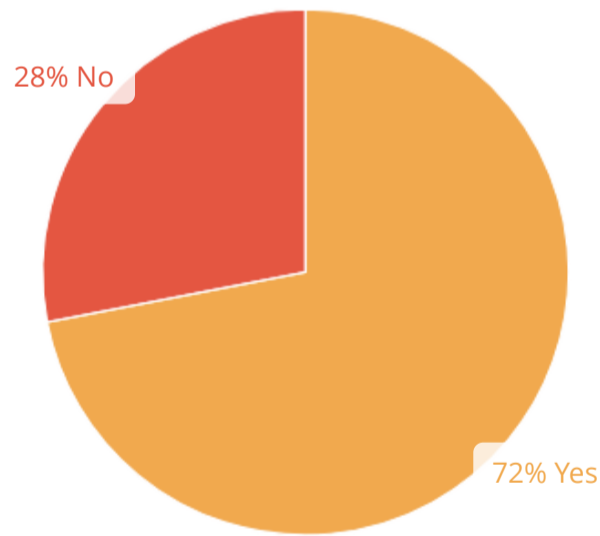

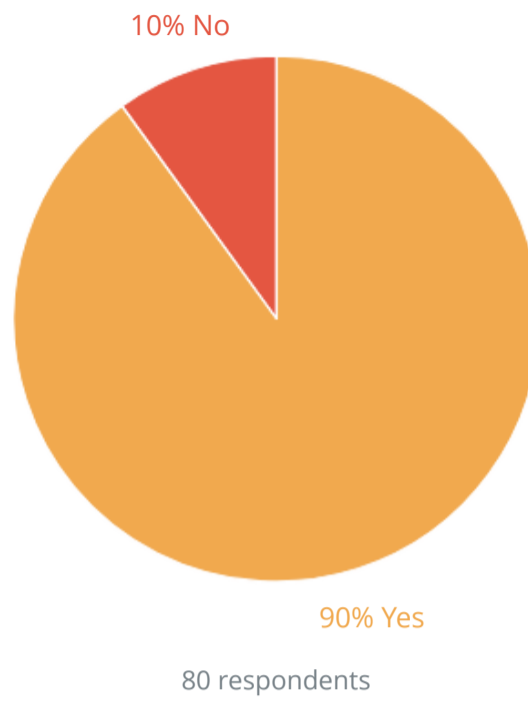

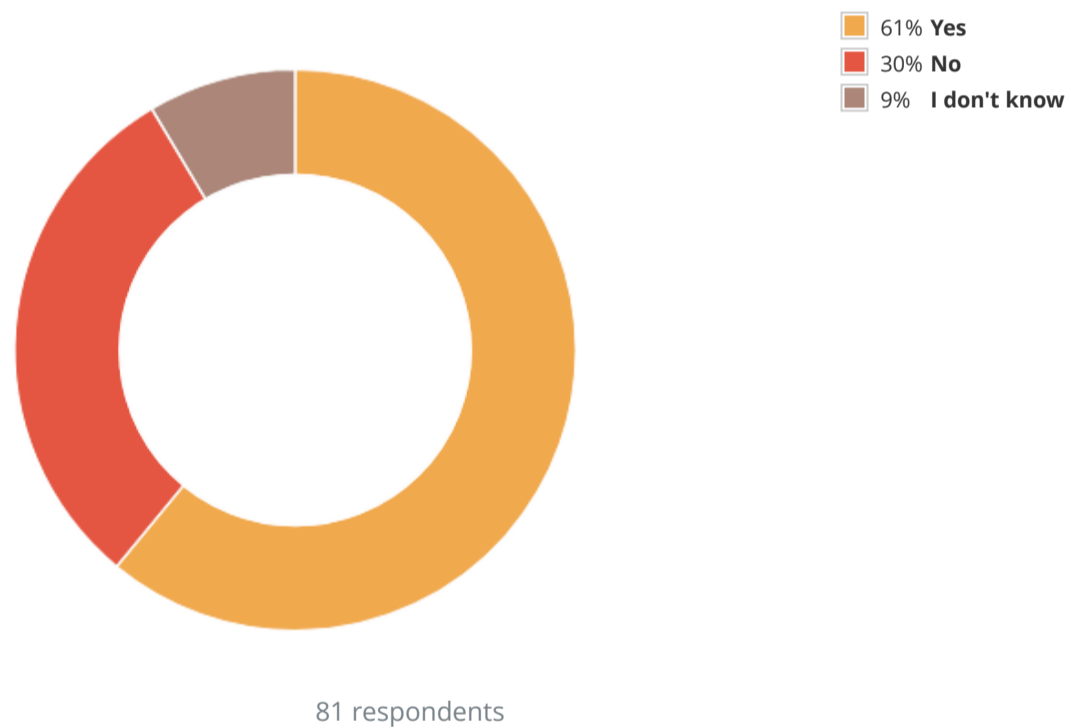

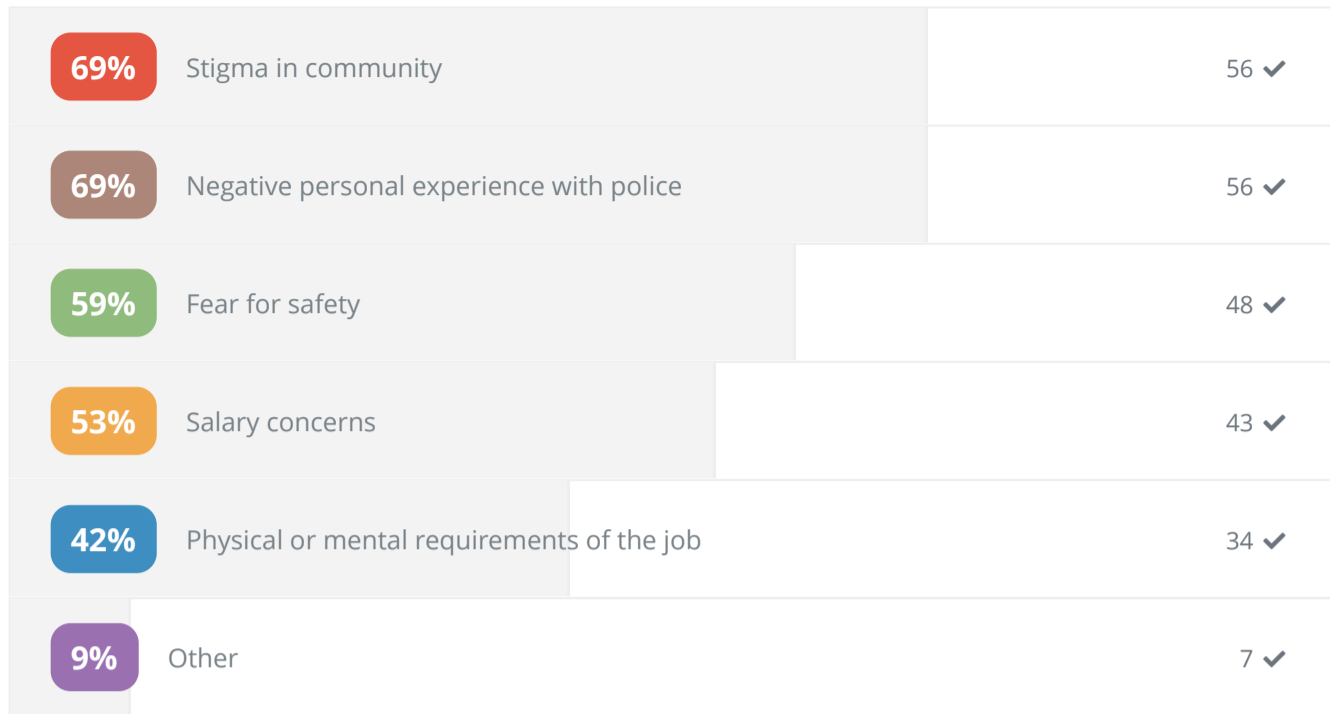

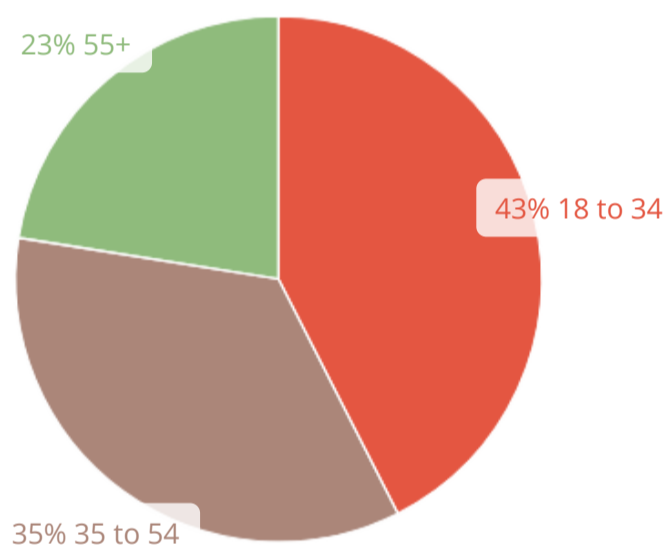

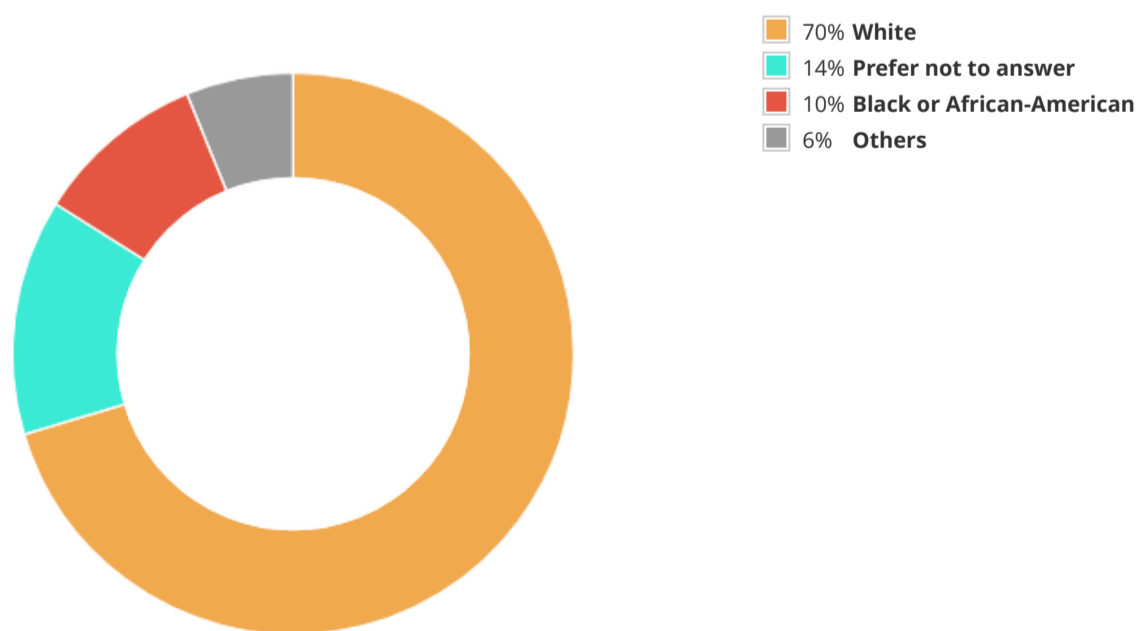

* What is your race/ethnicity?

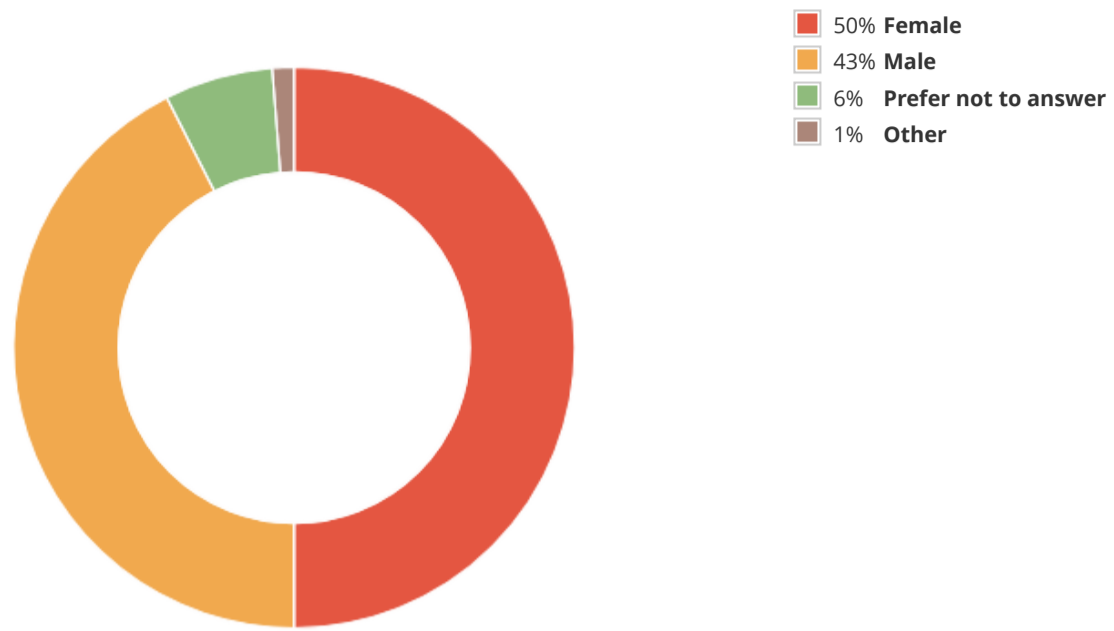

* What is your gender?

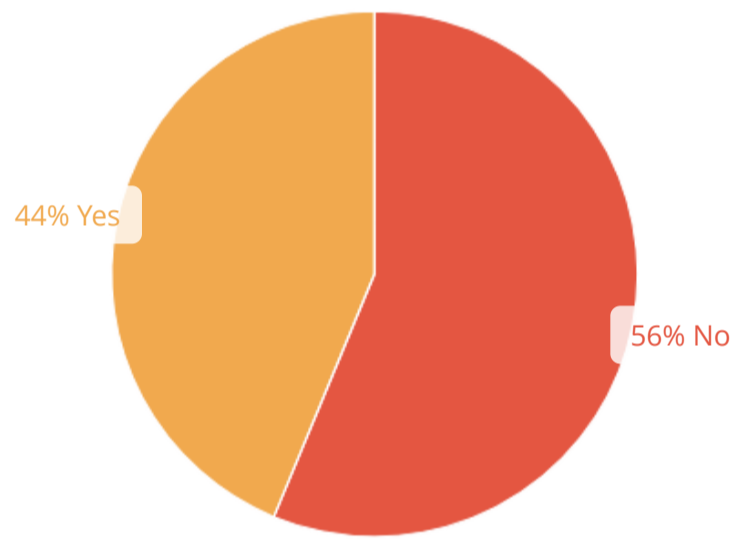
