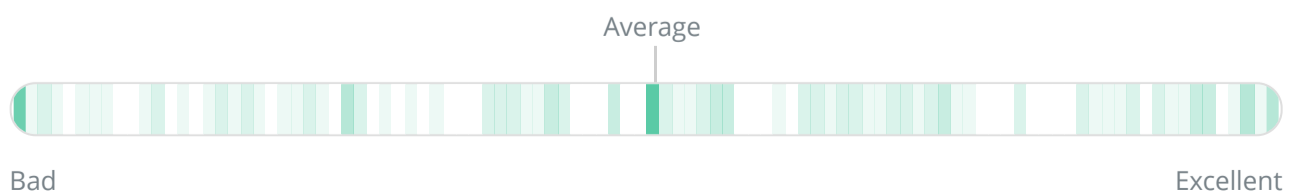

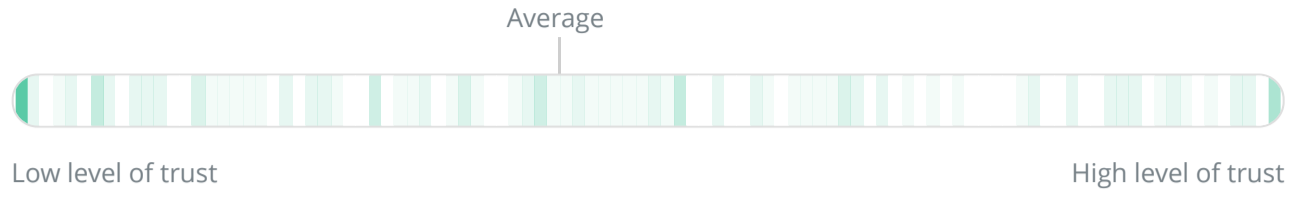
* How would you rate your overall experience with the Greenville Police Department?

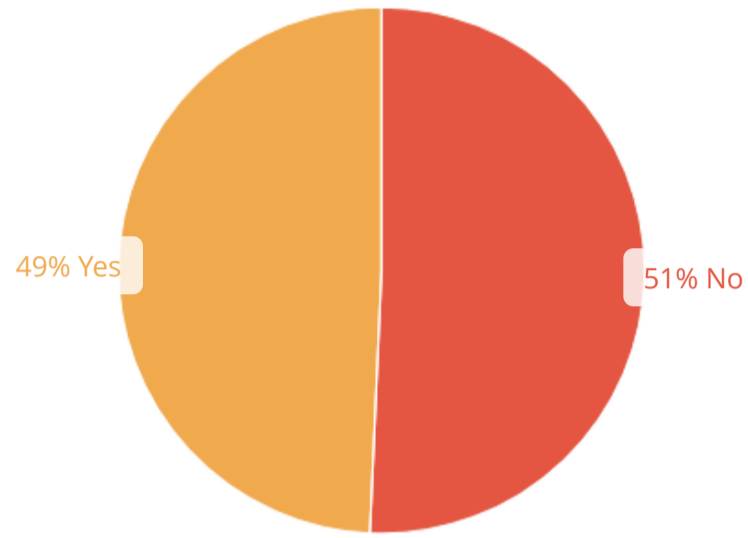
* What is your level of trust and confidence in the Greenville Police Department? *Use your mouse or finger to adjust the slider below.*

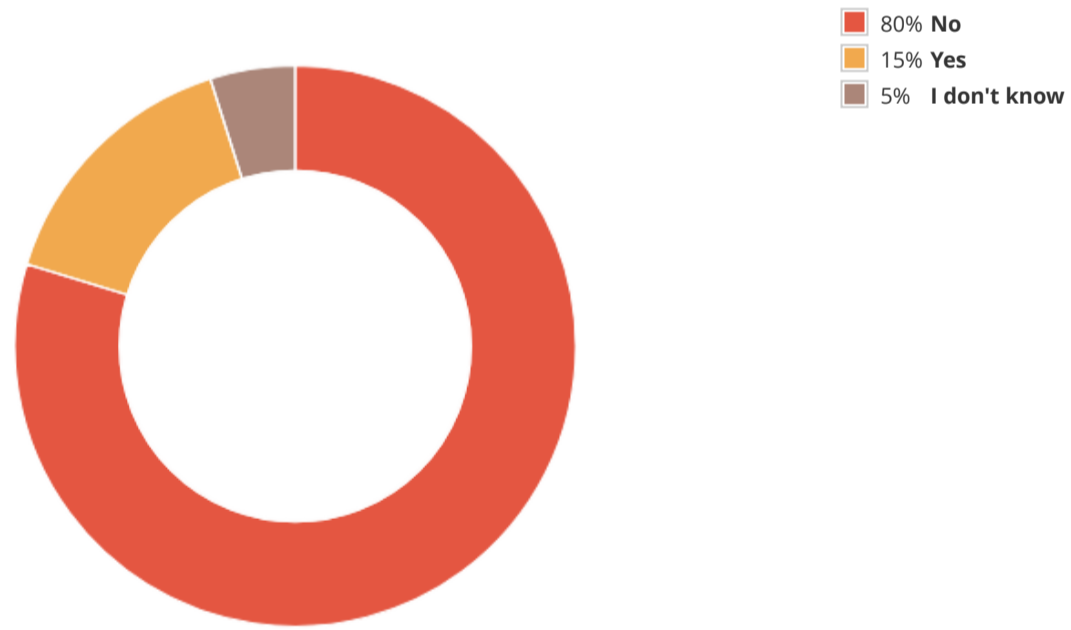

* In general, do you believe that law enforcement throughout the nation treats all racial/ethnic groups fairly?

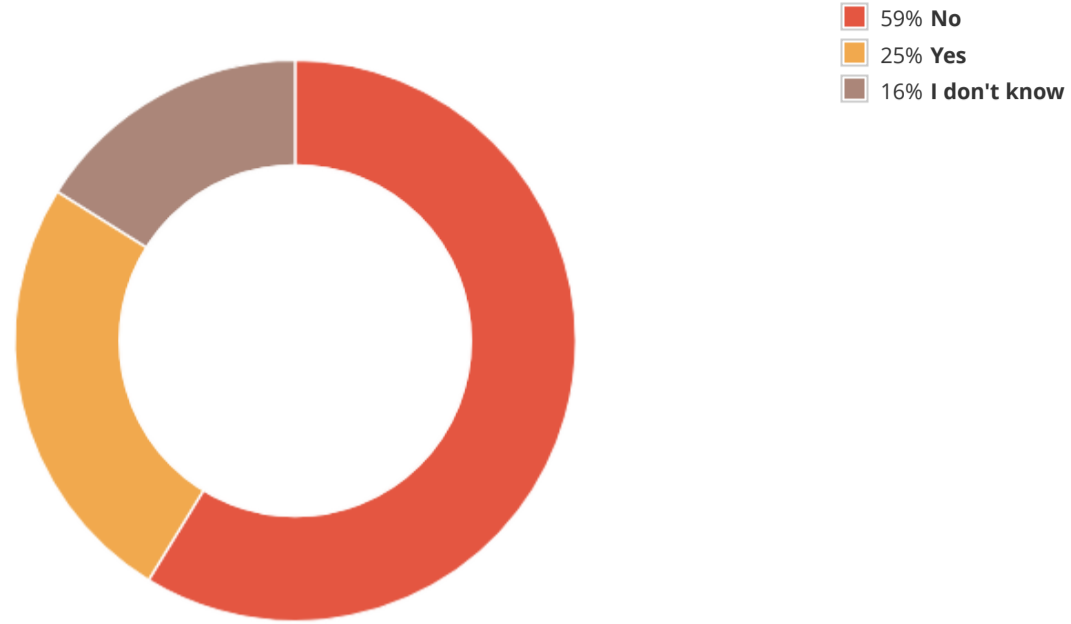

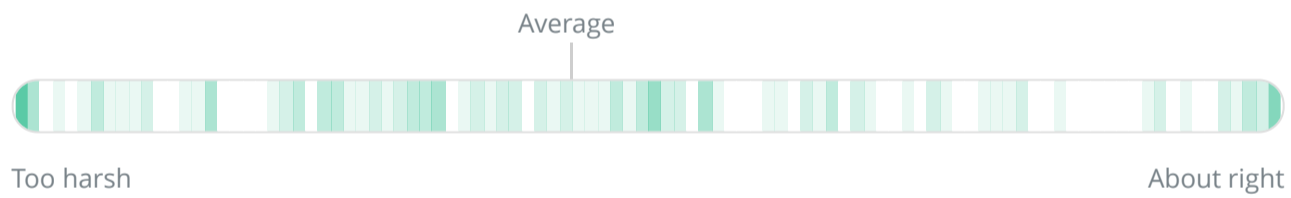
* In general, how would you describe the tactics used by law enforcement throughout the nation? Use your mouse or finger to adjust the slider below.

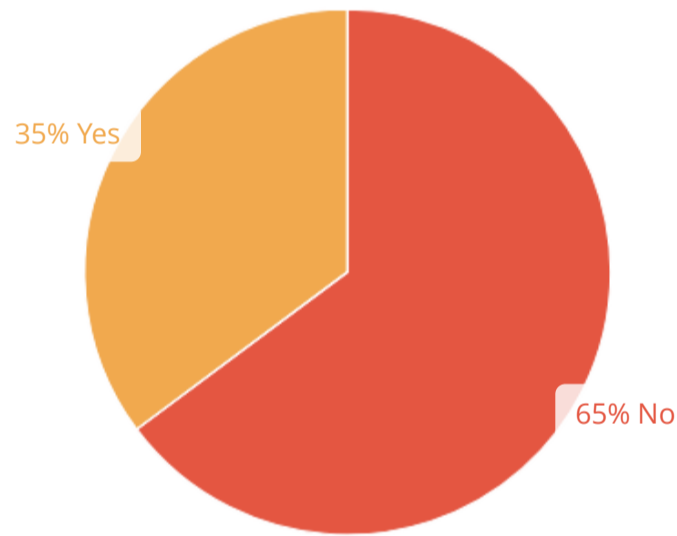

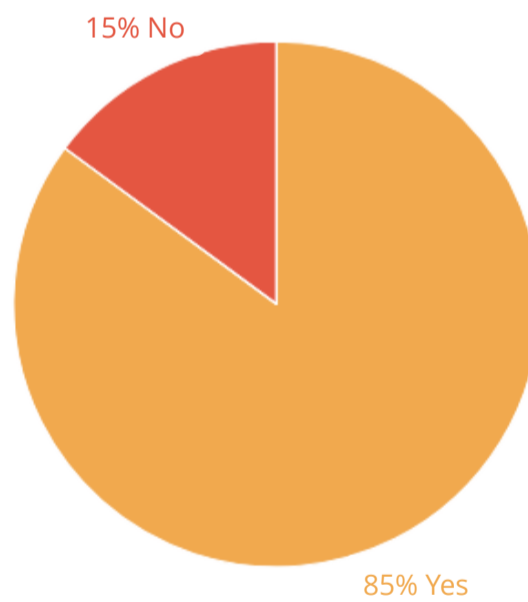

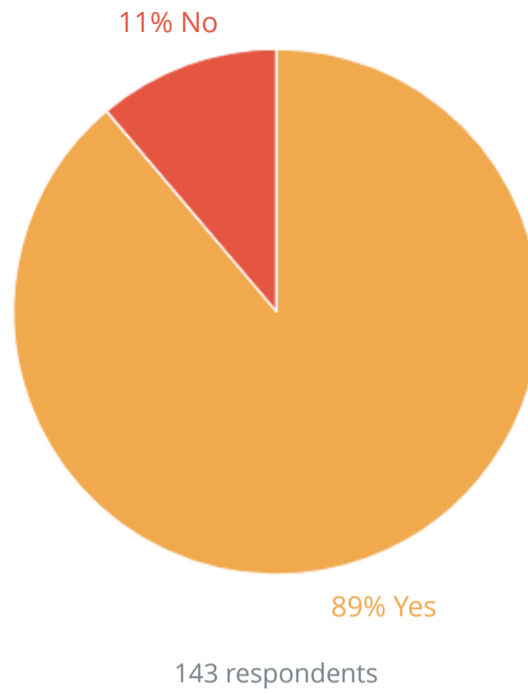

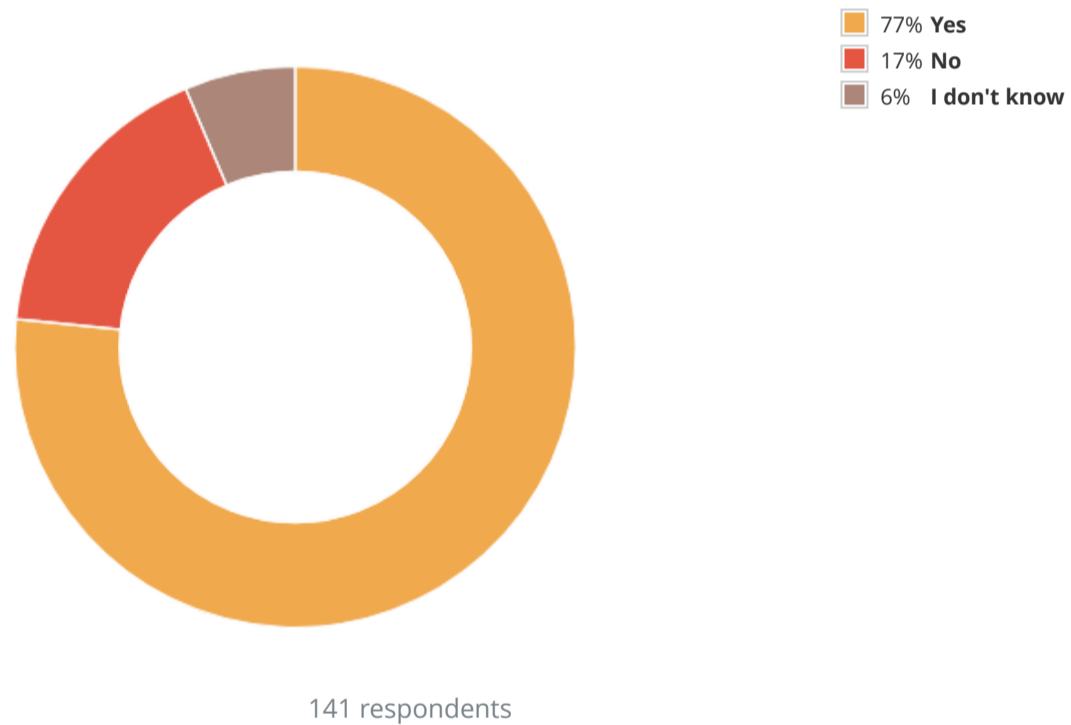

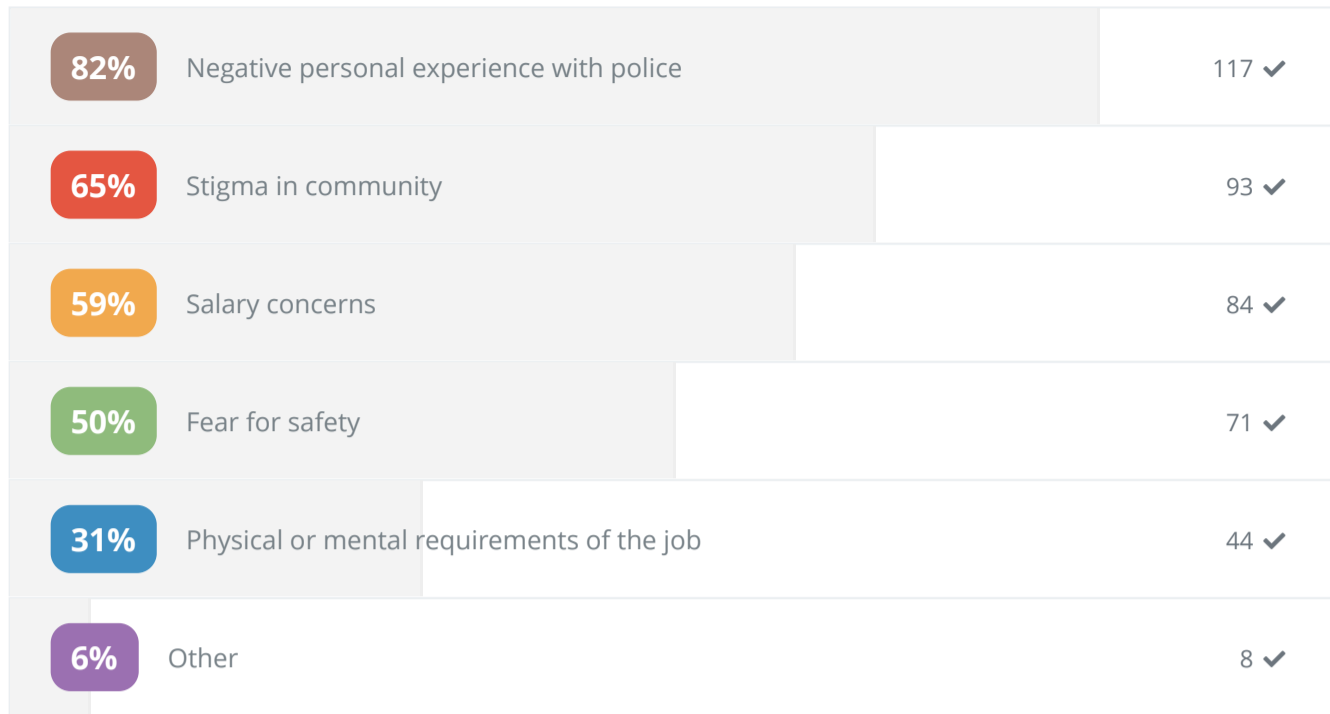

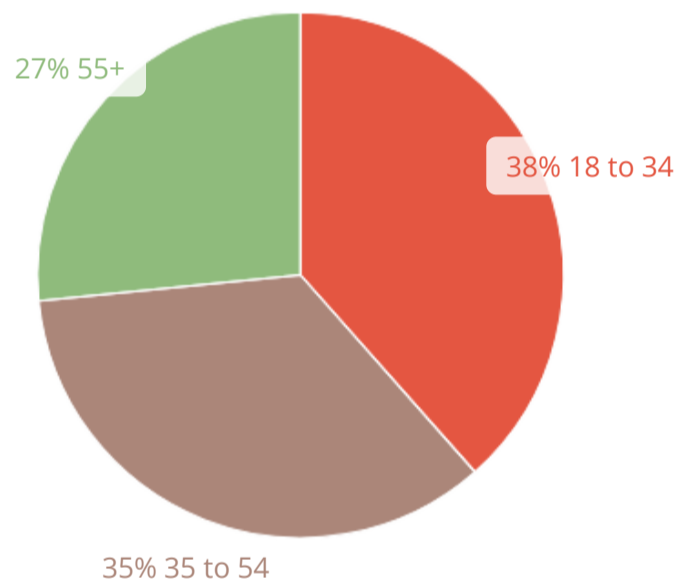

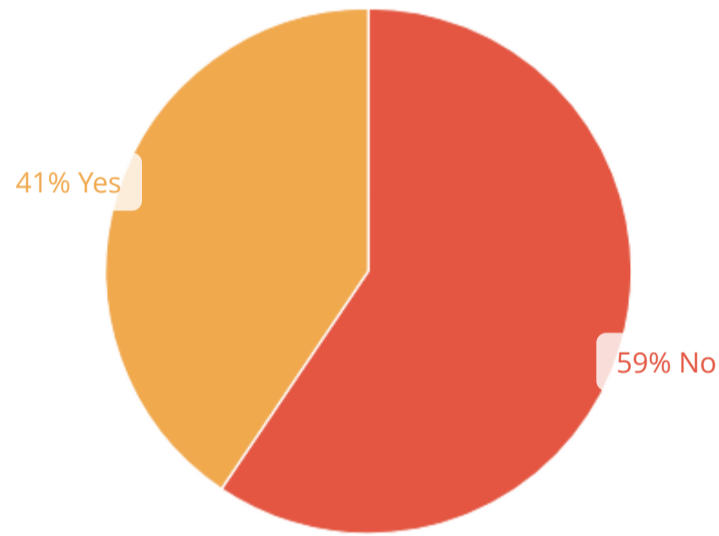

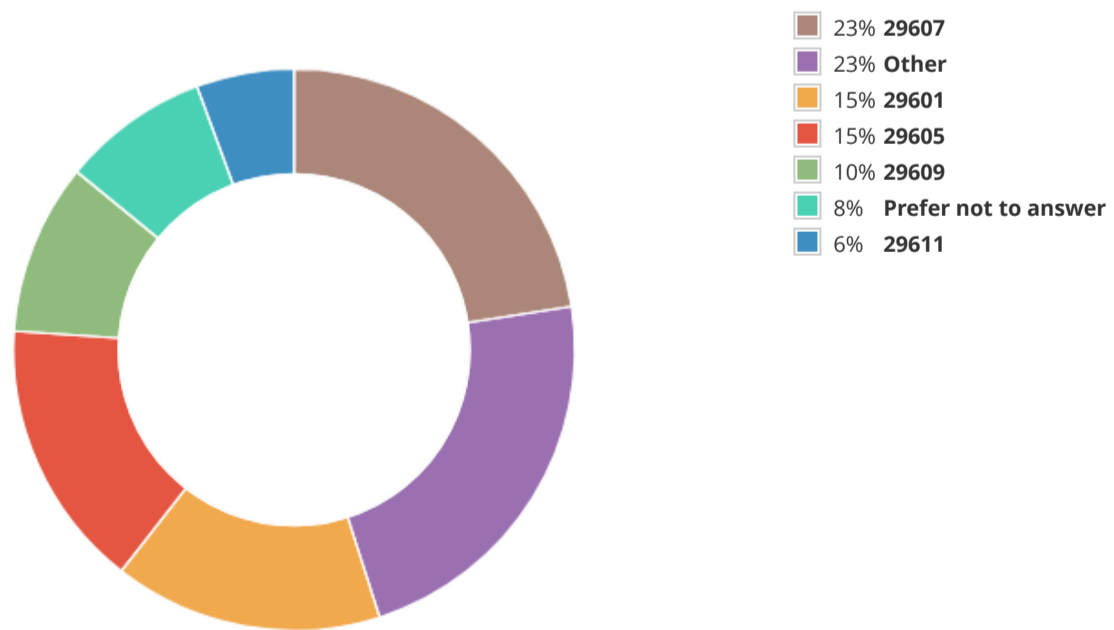
