

## **Instructions for printing and posting signage**

The sign included in this document should be printed at full size, which is 8" x 12."

On a standard printer, use a Tabloid (11" x 17") size paper and then trim to the final size.

Signs must be posted at each entrance into a building where a concealable weapon permit holder is prohibited from carrying a concealable weapon, whether concealed or openly carried.

The signs prohibiting concealable weapons on buildings must:

- Contain the words 'NO CONCEALABLE WEAPONS ALLOWED' in black one-inch-tall uppercase type at the bottom of the sign and centered between the lateral edges of the sign
- Contain a black silhouette of a handgun inside a circle seven inches in diameter with a diagonal line that runs from the lower left to the upper right at a 45-degree angle from the horizontal
- Show a diameter of a circle
- Be clearly visible from outside the building
- Be 8" x 12" inches tall in size
- Be placed not less than 40 inches and not more than 60 inches from the bottom of the building's entrance door
